



Position: Greens Attendant (Full-time and part-time available)

Department: Course and Grounds

Reports to: Superintendent and/or Assistants

The Greens Attendant performs maintenance and repair tasks to ensure that the golf course, course buildings and grounds are maintained to Club standards. Tasks might be specific in nature to the applicants' experience and ability.

Responsibilities:

Maintenance tasks

- Cuts and trims grass in areas such as greens, fairways, roughs and lawns.
- Rakes, weeds and grooms edges of bunkers.
- Applies fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides and fungicides if licensed.
- Moves holes and tee blocks
- Prunes and cuts tree limbs and debris.
- Cleans, greases and fuels equipment such as carts, utility vehicles, mowers and club vehicles.
- Performs general clean-up tasks such as removing debris from the course and cleaning the shop.
- Assists the Gardner by planting, weeding, cultivating and watering the Club gardens.

Repairs

- Applies seed and top dressing to areas where turf has been damaged.
- Removes old grass and replaces with sod to repair damaged areas.
- Maintains and repairs course buildings, irrigation system, bridges, benches, ball washers and other course facilities and equipment.

Other

- Complies with Club policies and procedures.
- Performs other tasks as assigned by management.
